The Association of Supply Chain Professionals (ASCP) is India's first association for supply chain management professionals and academicians which endeavors to practice quality supply chain & logistics practices and, in the process, help professionals and students to build up desired levels of expertise and skill.

The Association provides opportunities for professionals to communicate, develop and improve supply-chain managerial skills and create awareness about innovations and appropriate supply-chain systems for efficient business growth. It works towards connection professionals, education aspirants, skill development creating jobs and thus contribute to nation-building.

ASCP has conceptualized to recognise the works and contributions of institutions (Public and Private sector), NGOs, Business Professional and Young Student Managers in the domain of Sustainable and Green Supply Chain making significant impact on the lives of people and business and which are working towards meeting one or more of the SDGs.

ASCPs **Responsible Chain Awards** are now in its 3rd year and the prestigious awards have emerged as a desired platform to elevate the profile of individuals and organisations who have shown exemplary results in improving their supply chain. By recognizing outstanding achievement in supply chain, the ASCP awards for excellence are a fantastic opportunity to gain enhanced brand credibility and respect in the industry.

ASCP 2026 AWARDS WILL BE AWARDED IN THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES

A. PRIVATE SECTOR (MEDIUM TO LARGE SCALE ENTERPRISES)*:

For initiating and implementing sustainable and green supply chain practices in their organization(s) and/or community services which has led to significant reduction of carbon footprint and encouraged/introduced sustainable practices in community life and that shows reduction in energy and resources used and which demonstrates credible and audited result that can withstand scrutiny, and also that considers all aspects of their operations and wider impacts both up and down stream.

B. PRIVATE SECTOR (SME AND MSM CATEGORY)*:

For initiating and implementing sustainable and green supply chain practices in their organization(s) and/or community services which has led to significant reduction of carbon footprint and encouraged/introduced sustainable practices in community life.

C. SUPPLY CHAIN INNOVATION AWARD:

Will be awarded to an organization/individual that demonstrates and innovative approach that enhance and improves the organization's supply chain and focuses on one significant innovation that has led to a transformation in the organization's supply chain.

**Categorization of enterprise (for the above two categories) will be done in accordance with Government of India prescribed limit with respect to annual turnover and investment.*

The enterprises should provide a declaration regarding the category for which they wish to be considered for the ASCP 2026 awards.

AWARD GUIDELINES

- Overall winning team(s) will be awarded during the premier Annual India Supply Chain Conference, which will be held in Mumbai on **11 September, 2026**.
- There is NO ENTRY FREE for participation. All registered participants will be provided e-certificate.
- Entrants may be contacted by ASCP during the judging process.
- The decision of ASCP and its judging panel shall be final. Neither discussion or correspondence shall be entered into in respect of this decision.
- All **winners** MUST be available to attend the annual Supply Chain Conference on **11 September, 2026**.
- Please note that ASCP does NOT bear any cost of transportation and boarding.

EVALUATION PARAMETERS

- Nomination from the enterprises will be evaluated by a team of global experts drawn from ASCP, academia and industry.
- The complete nominations will be evaluated on the basis of the following parameters: Purpose (weightage 25%), Activity (weightage 25%), Implementation Impact and KPIs (weightage 25%) and Practical Impact on Business and Society (weightage 25%).
- Nominations document should provide evidence of the above 4 parameters.
- The submission must be sent to **chronicle@ascp.co.in** indicating contact details of all participants.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR NOMINATION:

Nominations should be submitted in MS Word. Each abstract must be a maximum of one side of A4 (Font Size 11, Arial, Page Margins can be removed) and include the following headings:

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| • Purpose for bringing/introducing the change | • Implementation Impact with measurable KPI's |
| • Activity/Project Done in Green Supply Chain Practice | • Practical Impact in Business and Society |

The nomination should be accompanied by a Brief Profile of the Candidate/Corporate, Organisation Profile and Complete address and Contact details. High quality nominations are welcomed from both academics and professionals particularly working in the field of logistics and supply chain management.

Full responsibility for the submission rests with the author. Authors should take the necessary steps to obtain permission to publish or use of any material that might be protected by copyright. At least one of the authors is expected to attend and present the case if selected for the awards.

SUBMISSION TIMELINE

- Call for Nominations: **August 5, 2026**.
- Last date for Submission of Nominations: **August 25, 2026**.
- Final Decision by Juries: **September 1, 2026**.
- Presentation of Awards at the Annual Conference: **September 11, 2026**.
